Key Question: In your personal opinion, what is the one and only thing you can do to keep your scrawny little butt from burning in the fiery flames of HELL FOR ALL OF ETERNITY?

Transition Statement: I'd like to share with you how the Bible answers that question, if it is all right. There is a word that can be used to answer this question: **FAITH** (spell out on fingers).

F is for FLAMMABLE

We are all going to burn someday if we do not repent.

- *But unless you repent you will all likewise perish — Luke 13:3b, NKJV.*
- *If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered. And they gather and cast them into the fire, and they are burned — John 15:6, MKJV.*

A is for ASHES

Ashes are all that is left after you burn.

Ashes are available for ALL !!

- *For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. — Romans 3:23, NKJV.*
- *For the wages of sin is death... — Romans 6:23a, NKJV.*
- *And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes, He condemned them with an overthrow, setting an example to men intending to live ungodly. — 2Peter 2:6, MKJV.*

I is for INFERNO

To burn, you get thrown into a big lake of fire!

- *And death and hell were cast into the Lake of Fire. This is the second death. — Revelation 20:14, MKJV.*
- *And if anyone was not found having been written in the Book of Life, he was cast into the Lake of Fire. — Revelation 20:15, MKJV.*

Question: But how does it feel for a sinful person to burn in a big lake of fire?

T is for TORMENT

Torment is the pain and suffering you will feel while you burn!

- *And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever. And they have no rest day or night, those who worship the beast and its image, and whoever receives the mark of its name. — Revelation 14:11, MKJV.*

H is for HELL!!

Hell is where you are going to burn if you don't accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior right now!

Hell is here:

- *Life sucks, and then you die. - Dr. Daniel 1:1, NIBV.*

Hell is hereafter:

•And I say to you, My friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. But I will warn you of whom you shall fear: Fear Him who, after He has killed, has authority to cast into hell. Yea, I say to you, fear Him.- Luke 12:4-5, MKJV.

How?

How can a person avoid the pain and suffering of being burned into a worthless pile of ashes in a big lake of fire? By trusting in Christ and asking Him for forgiveness.

Take the step of faith described by another meaning of FAITH: Forsaking All, I Trust Him.

Now, understanding that if you don't turn to Jesus you will burn in HELL, do you want to accept Jesus as your personal Savior and Lord? Huh? Huh? Huh? **Then say it! SAY IT!! SAY IT!! SAY IT!! SAAAAAYYYYYY IIIIIIIIIITTTT!!!!**

Okay, Now Pray This Prayer:

“Lord Jesus, I know I am a sinner and have displeased You in many ways. I believe You died for my sin and only through faith in Your death and resurrection can I be forgiven. I want to turn from my sin and ask You to come into my life as my Savior and Lord. From this day on, I will follow You by living a life that pleases You. Thank You, Lord Jesus, for saving me from going to hell and being burned into a worthless pile of ashes in a big lake of fire. Amen.”

After you have received Jesus Christ into your life, tell a Christian friend about the important decision you have made. Follow Christ in believer's baptism and church membership. Grow in faith and enjoy new friends in Christ by becoming a part of His church and attending the Sunday School class a church has just for you. You'll find others who will love and support you.
